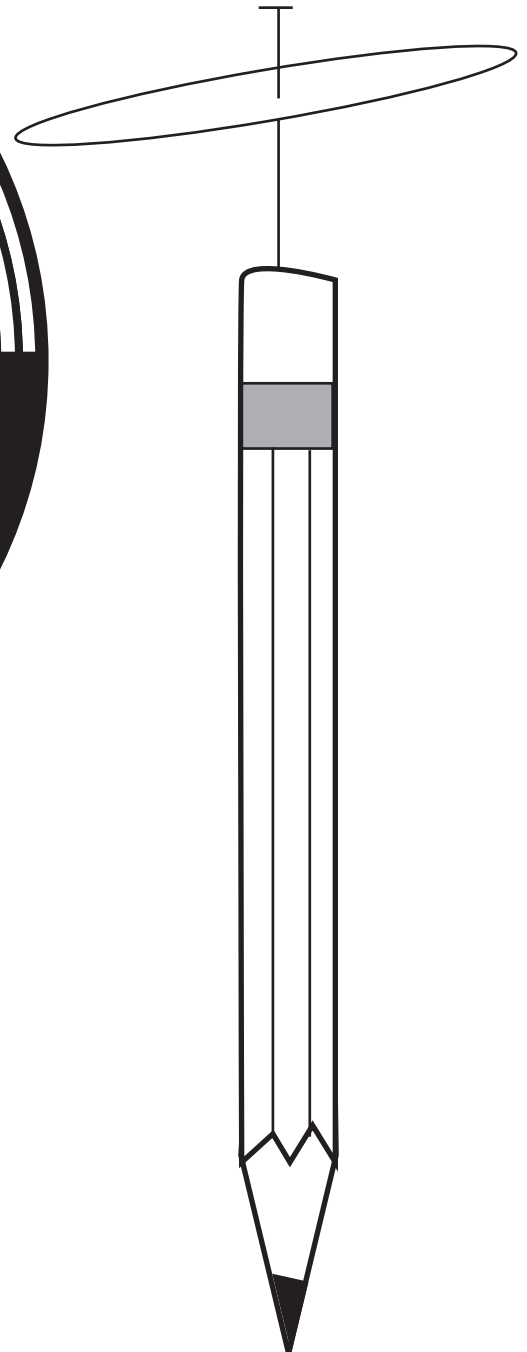
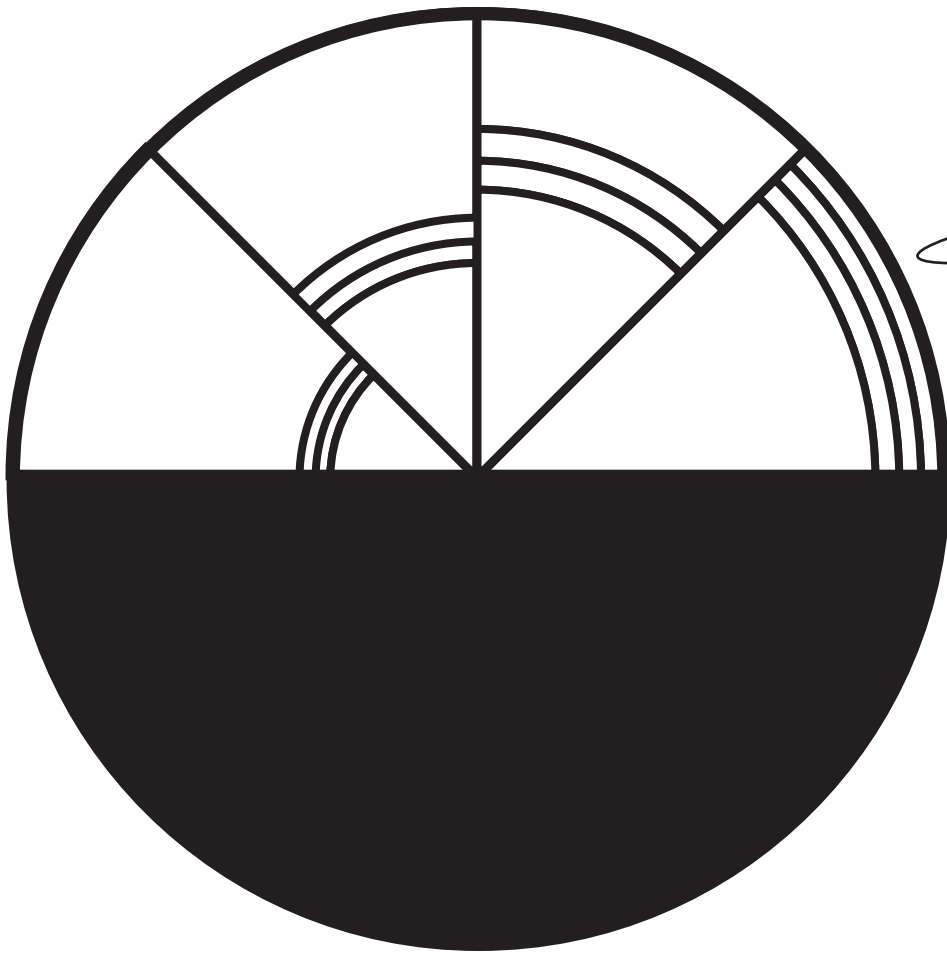


Benham Disk #1
