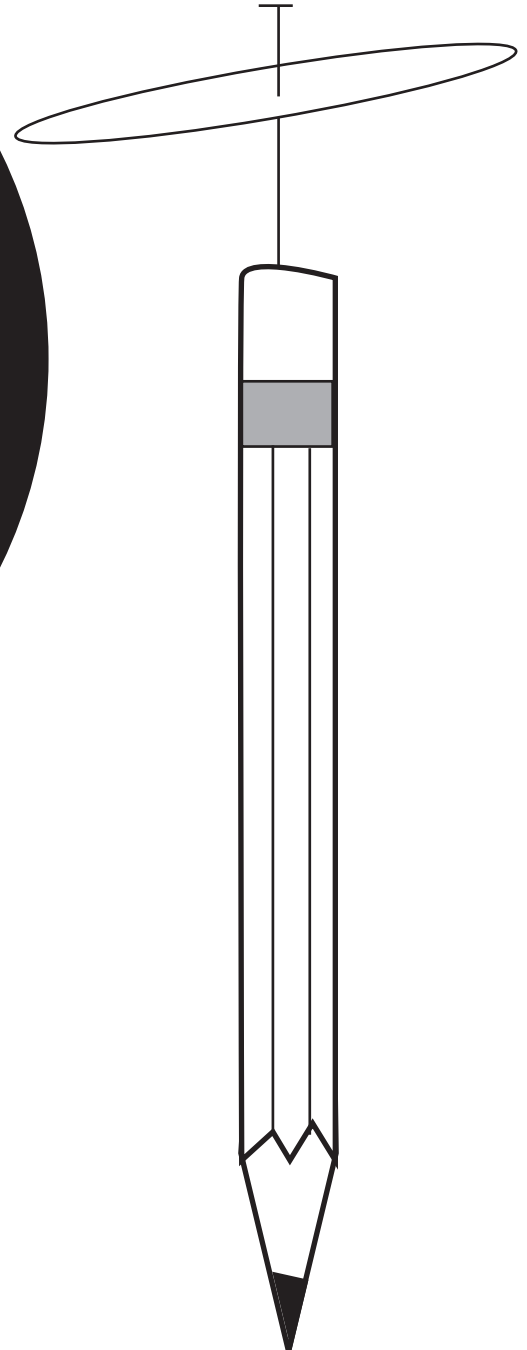
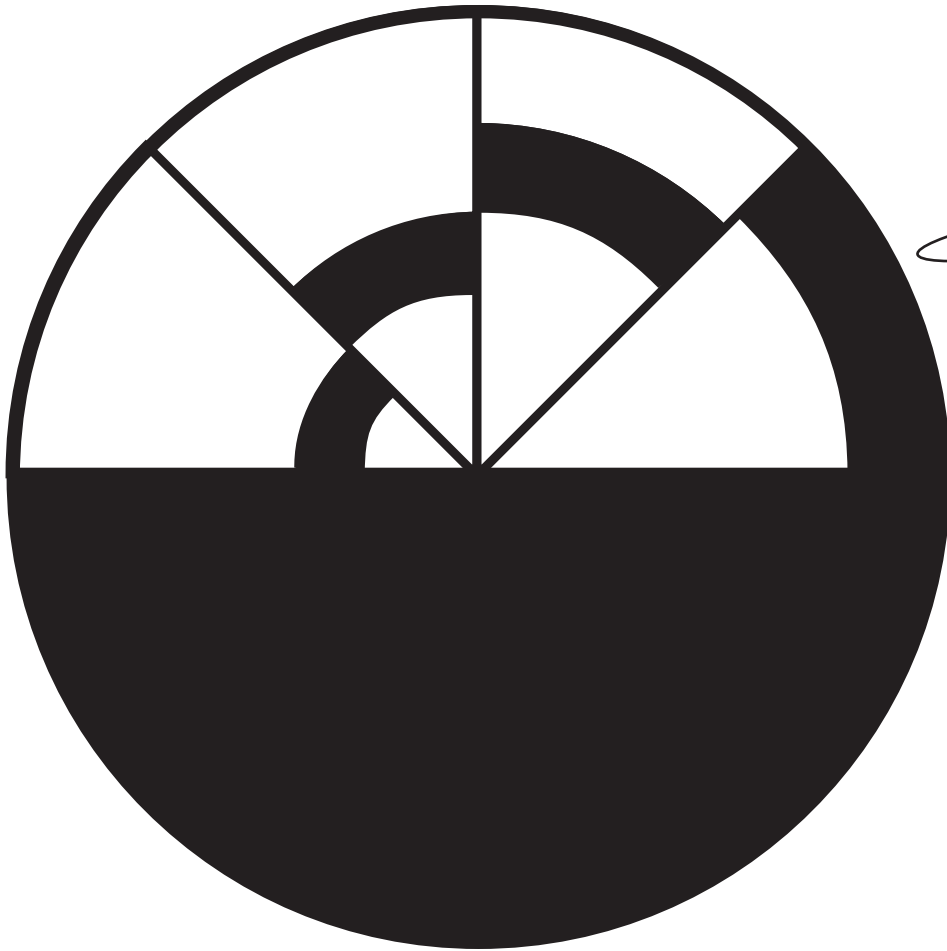


# Benham Disk #2
